**Veterans Honor Flight**

**Bill McGibbon**, one of our earliest Club members (President 1984-1985), shared his experiences – and photos --from 2 Veterans Honor Flights. Their mission is to transport American Veterans to Washington, DC, to visit memorials that honor their service and sacrifices. He said the Honor Flight Network has 131 hubs in 45 states, and has flown over 180,000 veterans to DC since the program started in 2005.



The flight from Tucson started with an honor guard and breakfast and included 25 vets plus guardians and nurses. Most of the vets are at least semi-mobile, but wheelchairs made some of the long walks manageable. Their next day included Arlington National Cemetery with the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier and the Changing of the Guard ceremony, several memorials (WWII memorial was authorized in 1993, completed in 2004), and half a day at Ft. McHenry, the location of the Star Spangled Banner composition. At each location the vets were applauded by the crowds. The trip back was made even more emotional with a mail call from family, friends, and school kids.

Veterans' expenses are paid by sponsors; guardians like Bill pay their own way. At this time there are over 27,000 vets on the waiting list, and roughly 640 WWII vets die each day.
