Dentists in Belize



Bill and Andi Grantham have been in Rotary most of a decade, at least, first in the Sahuarita Club, now with Valle Verde. **Bill** was a mechanical engineer from U of A, worked with Otis Elevator and with several companies in Juarez and Nogales, and now occasionally subs at Continental School.

Andi is a retired U of A histotechnologist who still does work there on research projects.

They told us Belize, formerly British Honduras, is on the Caribbean coast just south of Mexico. It was occupied by Mayans from 2000 BC, conquered by Spain in 1512, and gained independence from Britain in 1981. Its population is less than the City of Cleveland, and half of them live in poverty. Belize, along with 1 or 2 other primitive countries on the planet, still measures things in miles, pounds and gallons.

Their project sends 50 volunteers and portable dental equipment to Belize for 2 different weeks, where they do extractions, fillings, and even have



a lab that makes dentures. They can do 2000 fluoride treatments in just 2 hours. They ask, "If not now, when? If not you, who?"
