Community Service Awards



Marvin Hass is looking for nominations for this year's Community Service Above Self Awards. **Chuck Hill** of the Green Valley Fire Corps was last year's winner from among 7 nominees. He helped triple the number of bike lanes in Green Valley and helped the Fire Corps get a \$40,000 federal grant.

Horse'n Around Rescue Ranch

Steve Boice, a lifelong Arizonan who grew up in Sonoita, started his rescue ranch and foundation --a 501(c)3 – with Theresa Warrell in 2010. Their mission is to "rescue equines, restore their health and wellness, and provide a nurturing and natural environment



where 'horses can be horses' so they can be adopted into forever homes." Currently they have 59 horses and 1500 acres. All their help is volunteer. **Boice** shared stories and pictures of several horses that were starving or badly injured when rescued and that were pictures of health and vitality 6 to 9 months later. Their philosophy is very much to let the horse be a horse, which means pasture, being part of a herd, having plenty of food and water and room to move around. They mostly let the horse heal itself, but they also provide medical, dental, and hoof care. All their decisions are based on what's best for the horse.
