Foundation Minute

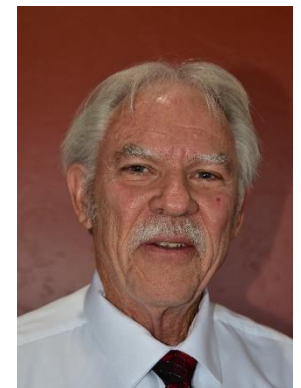


Chris Ashcraft's news is that we may well see the last case of polio this year. In 1988 there were 350,000 cases in 125 countries; in 2017 there were only 16 cases in 2. If we are finally successful, polio will join small-pox as the only diseases we have completely

eliminated from the earth.

The New Tax Law

Former Club member **Terry Cogan** gave us a very enlightening summary of the new federal tax law. Standard deductions double to \$12,000 each but the \$4100 personal exemption is gone. State and local taxes are capped at \$10k. Charitable contributions are preserved. The medical deduction remains the same. New tax brackets are 10,12, 22, 24, 32, 35, and 37 percent (he didn't say what income levels those are matched to). Inflation indexing has changed in a way that amounts to a hidden tax hike for individual filers. The ACA mandate (penalty for no health insurance) is out for 2018. And to frost the cake, the top corporate tax rate drops permanently from 35% to just 21%.
