Rotary on the Road



Last week our "meeting" was at the historic Hacienda de la Canoa, just across I-19 from Grill on the Green, and we had a great turnout of members, sojourners, and guests. We divided into 2 groups and each got a tour of the ranch. Docent **Mandy Vernalia** shared the extensive history,

from the millions of years involved in the "sky island" Santa Rita Mountains, the 10,000 years people have lived in the area, to the recent acquisition of the 4800 acres by the county in 2001. The Clovis Indians domesticated corn about 2000 BC, and pottery has been found dating to 200 BC. The Hohokam developed irrigation near the river and built villages from 650 to 1450 AD. The Spanish moved into the area in the late 1600's, and the de Anza expedition passed through the site in 1775 with 235 colonists heading for San Francisco (only 1 died, from childbirth, at the beginning of the journey).

Title was granted to the Ortiz family by Mexico, but the complexities weren't resolved until the Gadsden Purchase in 1853. The local Apaches were a frequent problem; it was more convenient to bribe them with food and such rather than to just defeat them. Maish and Driscoll bought the property from Ortiz and began running cattle in 1875, but the biggest modern influence was Levi Manning and his son Howell, whose progressive methods vastly expanded the ranch. From 1967 to 1997 various corporations held the land for its water rights. Since the Master Plan was finalized in 2007, buildings have been restored and a lake at the north end has been (accidentally) created.
