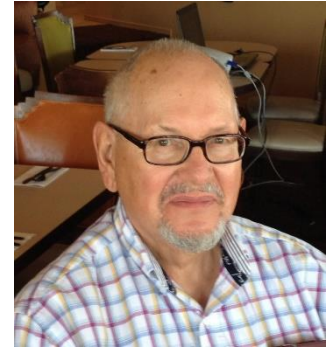
Food Fight Has Started

Rotary Trip to Ethiopia



Barbara Blake, who was President and co-founder of the SeaTac Rotary Club, shared her experience of a Rotary trip to Ethiopia 20 years ago. In conjunction with the Rotary Club of Addis Ababa, they built

cinder block homes for people who had been living in little more than cardboard and tarp sheds by the side of the road. With \$200,000 they built 100 homes, including very innovative latrines that separated liquid and solid waste for use in gardening. She said the Rotarians learned to eat with their fingers, got to visit the museum where Lucy, the 3.5 million year old human fossil, is displayed, provided over 500 polio vaccinations, and visited the largest hospital in the world for the repair of sexual mutilation (2500 surgeries per year). **Barbara**, whose husband taught her to mix mortar and lay brick, worked for 3 weeks alongside local Ethiopians and used their plans and materials. She has a degree in nursing and a master's in business administration.
