Dru Sanchez, who has been publisher at the GV News since August, worked for 21 years at the LA Times and 5½ years at the Arizona Daily Star. She said that when she started in LA the paper had 13,000 employees, but the number now is just 2000, largely because of automation and computers. She said **Dan**

Shearer, who has been editor for 9 years now, has the pulse of the community. She told us the paper is rolling out Journey Magazine, which will focus on the humanitarian side of our community. Changes to the paper are largely a response to the reader advisory board, which meets monthly. **Joyce Finkelstein** is one of the board members.

Dan Shearer showed us one of those changes: a tall tab format that is 5 inches shorter than older style, but there's no less content, and it is less likely to blow off a table. The paper has an e-edition, a website, and of course a Facebook page. **Shearer** said small community papers are doing better than big city papers because they specialize in local news. National news is available electronically. He distinguished between news, which reports events, and information, which includes sports scores and the stock market. In spite of that, the reporter's job has not changed.
