Vocational Student



Club President **Julie Reppenhagen** shared a letter from the AZ Vocational Fund student we sponsored, **Aziz Ajel**. He's gotten his FAA airframe license and will test for his power license. He's interviewed at several places for a job, including DynaCorp. He will be a speaker here at our Club in the near future.

Therapeutic Riding of Tucson

Sandy Webster, who has been with TROT for 7 years, was Canada's first female jockey. She told us TROT has been an accredited PATH (Professional Association for Therapeutic Horsemanship) center for 40 years. She explained that horses change lives physically because of their 4-beat walk. Riding a horse helps with sensory integration, improves perception, memory, and judgment, and given the instruction provided, even helps with the 3 R's. Horses also change lives emotionally and socially, much of which is due to the interaction of the riders with the TROT volunteers. The riding can serve as therapy after a stroke, for cerebral palsy, and for veterans with PTSD. **Sandy** presented (with links) extensive research results. For example, the Riding for Disabled Association tracked 181 disabled children in the UK and found 80% improved in physical ability and confidence, 75% improved in ability to communicate, and 82% improved in relationship building skills. Quoting Winston Churchill, "the outside of a horse is good for the inside of a man."
