Microcredit Project



President **Julie Reppenhagen** presented **Dan Stringham**, from the Tucson Sunrise Club, with a check for \$1000, our part in the District’s Microcredit Program in Mexico. **Stringham** reminded us of the huge difference a loan of even \$300 can make to someone who is struggling to start a business.

Reid Park Zoo



“Every animal in the zoo is an ambassador for its species in the wild” is a favorite saying of **Jed Dodds** (yes, **Justin’s** younger brother), whose passion for animals had him volunteering with a veterinarian at age 14. His passion was evident in his not needing a microphone during his talk. He has been zoo-keeper for all the animals in the zoo except the elephants and was in the zoo’s education department for 10 years. Besides showing us a fantastic collection of pictures of the zoo’s 300 animals, he also told us about the zoo’s plans to expand. The zoo is “dual run,” both by the city and the Zoological Society, a non-profit fundraiser. **Jed** told us about the zoo’s many programs, such as “Brew at the Zoo,” a fundraiser that brought in between \$60 and \$80 thousand in one evening, and the summer camp the zoo runs for kids in grades 1 through 6. He showed us pictures of the zoo’s brand-new health center. He talked about conservation, saying there are less than 2500 tigers left on earth, and that even though importing ivory into the US is illegal, selling it is not. He said that much of the zoo’s expansion is made possible with a 0.1¢ sales approved last January. It will bring in between \$4 million and \$8 million and make possible larger habitats.
