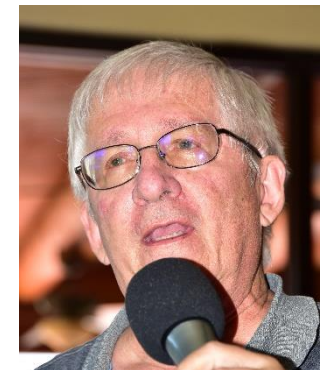
Rotary in Action



RI Representative **Chris Ashcraft** told us about a project supported by 6 Clubs in Addis Ababa (Ethiopia), in which poor kids are taught to train other kids in the skills needed to improve their lives, such as building latrines. Our donations are helping make the world a better place.

The Big Bang

Club Secretary **Michael Pease** filled in a short-notice speaker slot with a pair of PBS Space Time episodes about the Big Bang. The first emphasized the parts of the theory we are really sure about based on observations and mathematics: the universe is expanding, so it must once have been smaller and hotter. The uniformity of the cosmic microwave background implies a period of very rapid expansion. The predictions of our theories have been tested in particle colliders like the LHC in Europe, and they describe the universe back to a very tiny (10^{-32} second) moment after the beginning. The big bang itself, however, is beyond the scope of Einstein’s General Theory of Relativity and requires a theory of quantum gravity, which we have not yet achieved. Such a theory, sometimes called TOE (Theory of Everything), has been a sort of carrot on a stick for physicists for most of the last century. The problem with the various theories is that they cannot be tested (at present) with anything we might build on Earth. The test would need energies a trillion times what’s produced in the Large Hadron Collider.
