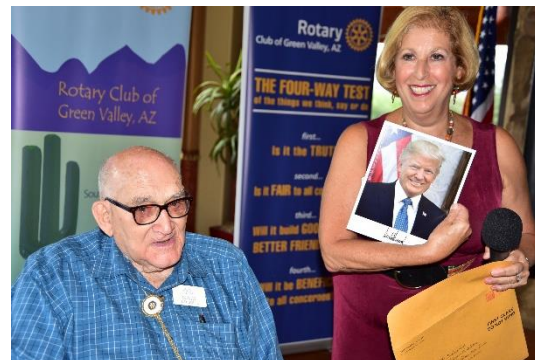
Get Ready for Brats

Gayle Creamer has been a Green Valley resident for 26 years. She's a business owner, has served on the Board of Directors for Casa de Esperanza, and has been President of the Continental School Parent Involvement Network.



Gayle gave us an update on last year's jacket drive. From an initial goal of 200 jackets, she collected 1100 and gave out 800 in Amado. She raised \$1700 and used the money to shop for missing sizes. Our own **Jill**, **Katie**, and **Jack** helped, and both Rotary and the Fire Department helped to make contributions tax deductible.

This year her goal is 1500 jackets (new and gently used). She wants to see every man, woman and child in our communities warm this winter. The start date for collection is September 1, donation boxes will be at the Fire Departments, and the distribution will be at the Amado Food Bank. People will be able to pick out what fits and what they like. She told a story about a little boy last year who really wanted, and eventually found, a green jacket. **Julie** will have a sign-up sheet for those who would like to help with the distribution. Meanwhile we are getting the word out to Tubac, and Rio Rico, as well as Amado, and to GVNews, KGVV, and Sopori School.
