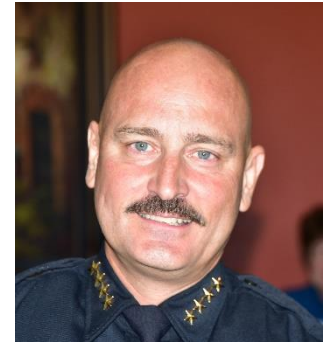
Rotary Minute



A Packers fan from Wisconsin, **Paul Loomans** shared his history with us. He worked for John Deere but after 5 moves in 10 years wanted a change. He moved to Phoenix 20 years ago and worked in pharmaceuticals but wanted something non-profit, mission-oriented, and that led him to Green Valley and La Posada.

What's a Constable?

Born at Davis Monthan AFB, enlisted in the Marines at age 18, **Thomas Schenek** became a Tucson police officer in 1991, and over 24 years worked in Patrol, in the DUI task force, and as a motorcycle officer. He explained that Pima Co. has 8 elected Justices of the Peace and 8 elected Constables. He said that to get elected he had to walk a lot of parking lots, but he unseated a 12-year incumbent who happened to be a friend.



The constable makes arrests from court orders, things like restraining orders, evictions, and writs of execution (seizing assets). He is rarely in his office, which is in Green Valley next to the Justice Court, working from about 1 PM to 9 PM. While he and about half of the constables wear uniforms, largely because of police backgrounds, half do not. He told us that his power of arrest is more limited than that of police.

In connection with his work with canines, he said the dogs are cross-trained, either apprehension + drugs or apprehension + explosives.
