Vocational Chair **Marvin Hass** reminded us that service is a central aspect of *The Object of Rotary* and our weekly *Four-way Test*. As a former Navy scullery mate (not to mention, husband), service is 2nd nature for him.

Cybersecurity

Jerry Weygint, Director of Information Technology at La Posada, worked for 19 years as IT manager at Tucson Medical Center, 5 years at Sunquest as Manager of Global Interoperability, and is currently working on an MBA online. He warned us that our age group is especially vulnerable because we are more trusting, have more resources, fewer computer skills, and are easily frightened. His 4 points were



1) protect your privacy. He pointed out the Equifax breach affected over 146 million people but had no adverse consequences for Equifax.

2) look out for villains on the World Wide Web. This includes googling safely (<https://> means secure connection) and using pop-up blockers, keeping the operating system up to date, and using anti-virus software like Webroot,

3) beware of telephone scams. The IRS **will not** call you. Your grandkids **are not** penniless in a foreign country.

4) don’t click on links in email you have the slightest doubt about, and when it comes to passwords, length trumps complexity. Above all, use back-ups.
