**Brats Cookout**

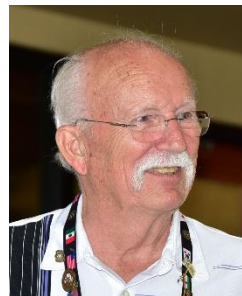

**BizEDGE**

**Michael Jansen**, an economic development specialist for the Town of Sahuarita, was born in Tucson, got his BA in political science from Dordt College in Iowa and a Master's in Public Policy from the University of Southern California.



He talked to the Club about Sahuarita's BizEDGE, their small business initiative. EDGE is Energize, Develop, Grow, Excel. It was funded with a grant in 2015 from Freeport McMoRan to develop the Town's business hub. They are in a relationship with the small business development center of Arizona. Last year they worked with 3 businesses – Copper Fitness, a market, and a vet clinic. The chosen companies had to be in business at least 2 years and had to do more than \$100,000 in business the previous year. The workshops BizEDGE provided led to presentations by the companies in a "shark tank" kind of competition, showing off what they learned and how they planned to put it to use.

This year they are working with 3 more companies – Control Vision, Suburban Real Estate, and Native Gardens of Green Valley. They are open to both Green Valley and Sahuarita companies. They are also planning a 1-day boot camp for CEO's of start-ups.

**Jansen** also talked about SAMTEC, the Sahuarita Advanced Manufacturing and Technology Center, for which they've received a \$3 million grant from the US Department of Commerce. They will build a 20,000 ft<sup>2</sup> building on 16-acre site on the SW corner of I-19 and Sahuarita Blvd. The center will allow Hydronalix (robot boats) and Control Vision (optical sensors) to expand their existing operations in Sahuarita. Sahuarita is one of the fastest growing communities in AZ (600% from 2000 to 2014), and its citizens will want employment options.
