**Outside In**

**Michael Pease**, Club Secretary and former math and philosophy teacher, couldn't resist filling the 20-minute program time with a video from The Geometry Center showing how to turn a sphere – a theoretical one – inside out without poking a hole in it the way a physically real one would require. The video established a background of concepts using 2 dimensional curves, such as the turning number of a curve, then showed how, with corrugations in the curve, any curve could be transformed into another with the same turning number. The idea applied to a sphere involves corrugating the surface, pushing the top and bottom partway through, twisting to undo the incomplete loops, and then undoing the corrugation.



Unfortunately, mind-blowing as the ideas are if clearly heard, the background noise at Torres Blancas made the whole thing virtually incomprehensible. **Pease** vows to inflict no more math on the Club for the rest of the year.
