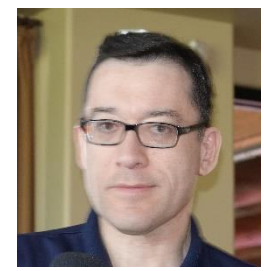
And Fortune Smiles



Past President, and currently Foundation President, **Joyce Finkelstein** drew the joker last week and won \$1787. It is her second win. Since we started the raffle in 2013, we have had 10 winners. **Chet Davis** won 3. The game has paid out \$13,186 to the winners and earned \$19,780 for Club expenses.

Climbing Mt. Everest

Dr John Klein was raised in Tucson, educated at UC Berkeley, University of Madrid, Medical College in Wisconsin, Maimonides Medical Center in New York, and studied sports medicine at Stanford. He's been an orthopedic surgeon in Green Valley since 2004. He was 40 lbs heavier then, but he joined the Southern Arizona hiking club and has climbed over 1000 peaks in Arizona. His first glaciated peak was Mt Hood in Oregon.



His Everest climb involved long bus rides through Nepal, from Kathmandu (a 3rd world capital to avoid) to Lukla, and a week from there to the Everest base camp. The villages have wifi and thrive on the tourist trade. The route passes many memorials to deceased climbers. He spent 6 weeks in base camp tents at an elevation of 17,500 ft, eating well; everyone else spent 8. He'd acclimated early. From base camp one of the first obstacles is the Khumbu icefall, which has to be traversed in 1 night because the sun softens the ice. The climbers spend days at each camp to further acclimate, with pulmonary and cerebral edema the prize for failure. Most of the climb past base camp requires oxygen tanks and masks. All supplies like that are carried by Sherpas. Assisting climbers has become a tribal industry. **Dr. Klein** intends to go back.
