Avoiding Investment Fraud

Terri Alexon, who is the Investor Education Coordinator for the AZ Corporation Commission's Securities Division, has degrees from ASU in business and communication, and she has been with the Commission since 2002. She did not tell us where to invest but focused on avoiding fraud.



Using a number of cartoons and video enactments, she explained that almost anything can be a security if it involves investment of money or property, has an expectation of profit, is a common business enterprise, and is primarily based on the efforts of others. More than \$50 billion is lost to fraud each year, and Americans 65 or older are much more likely to be targeted and 34% more likely to lose their money than people in their 40's. Victims tend to be married males, age 55-65, self-reliant, college educated, financially literate risk-takers. They rely on friends and family for advice and don't do independent research. They fail to check background and registration of the financial professional and his product, and they can't spot the persuasion tactics of the fraudsters.

Persuasion tactics include phantom riches – dangling the prospect of wealth, social consensus – everyone wants it so it must be good, reciprocity – doing a small favor in return for a big one, and scarcity – if it's rare it must be valuable.

Prevention techniques include avoiding companies that lack audited financials and a verifiable business history. Screen phone calls. Remember, if it sounds too good to be true,
