Game for the World

Anne Harmon, a member of the Tucson Sunrise Rotary Club, was born in Canada, lived and worked in South Africa for 10 years, and has lived in Tucson for 22 years. She has 40 years international experience in human resources management, training, and development.



She is founder and owner of 2 corporations that focus on educational board games. *Know Me* is a suite of relationship and trust-building games. *Game for the World*, developed and distributed by the 2nd (nonprofit) corporation, focuses on HIV/AIDS. It was born in Tucson, launched in Mexico City in 2008, and is



now in use in 32 countries. It is designed for ages 12 and up. Played as a board game, it gets people talking in a safe way about AIDS. It has Ministry of Education

approval in Kenya (elements from the country's flag have become part of the game), and it is manufactured there, creating jobs. University interns have been involved, and our own **Charlene Westgate** contributed art to the game. Kenya has the 4th largest AIDS infection rate (South Africa is largest), and AIDS is the leading cause of death for African women.
