Scotland Theme Meeting

Rotary and Polio

Phyllis Bannister, last year’s Community Service Award winner, was a much-loved 4th grade Literature Circle facilitator at Continental School while her health



allowed. She had polio when she was 11 months old, was paralyzed from the waist down, and eventually learned to walk with braces and crutches. She told us about the 1 million polio survivors in the US and about post-polio syndrome, which leaves a person with fatigue and brain fog.

Past DG **Michael Drake** reviewed Rotary’s fight against polio, which started in the Philippines in 1979, The Global Polio Eradication Initiative, started in 1989, brought the incidence of polio worldwide down from 350,000 per year to just 22 cases in 2017, at a cost of \$1.2 billion to Rotary and a total cost worldwide of \$9 billion. It is estimated to cost another \$6 billion to finish. We need 0 cases for 3 years to declare victory. He also talked about the growth of Tucson’s Ride Against Polio, which grew from \$2000 to \$45 million in just 7 years.
