Our Club met the 2 exchange students we are helping support this year, along with Valle Verde and the Nogales Club, who are hosting them. **Rovena**, who is from Brazil, is into soccer, and **Mate**, from Slovakia, is into football.

Food Bank Update

Debby Acuña, who has worked with non-profits over the last 30 years, assumed the role of Manager for both the Amado and Green Valley Food Banks in 2018, replacing former Club member **Mary Jane Goodrick**, who is currently involved with the Sustainable Family Coalition.



Debby talked at length about how the Food Bank is taking a holistic look at Food Bank clients, what keeps them needing services, how the Food Bank can help, how they can have a greater impact. They provide help with SNAP applications, how to dress for a job application, and with transportation, just to mention a few. She told us that 1 in 4 kids and 1 in 5 adults in Arizona are at risk for hunger, that Arizona has the 5th highest rate of childhood hunger in our country, and she said 17% of our Community Food Bank clients are seniors.

The Food Bank distributed 298,986 food boxes to 191,233 families last year. An additional 8,000 seniors got additional hunger relief, and over 6,500 volunteers helped them achieve that. 3,282 people attended community farm and garden workshops put on by the Food Bank, and 1,890,064 servings of local produce were grown with the Food Bank's help. 3095 children attended nutrition classes. Unlike some non-profits, 97¢ of every dollar raised by the Food Bank goes directly to food and programs.
