What’s Going on at the Border

Tony Vartola, who’s been a Rotarian since 2000, was General Manager for Jeld-Wen Windows and Doors in Nogales, Sonora for 12 years and served on the Board of Directors for the Association of Maquiladoras (4 years as President). Now as Operations Manager for Port Devanning Services, he works alongside US Customs at the Port of Entry in Nogales.



He pointed out the big deal made of the fentanyl seizure at the border in January, showed it was the only one, and then told us that 1000-1500 trucks cross through the port daily, roughly 35,000 in January, each capable of hiding and carrying 20,000 lbs of marijuana, but only about 1% of trucks are actually stopped and closely inspected. It would take 400 people with backpacks to carry as much as 1 truck through the back country. Obviously, the cartels would use that option only as a distraction.

On the plus side, new technology (muon tomography), which has detected previously unknown rooms in the Great Pyramids, is being developed to read the cosmic ray scattering from trucks without invasive x-rays. They are busy teaching the computers to tell the difference between cucumbers and kilo bags of pot. Pity no one listened to William F. Buckley’s solution.
