GREEN VALLEY ROTARY SCHOLARSHIP POLICY

The Green Valley Rotary Club will each year award up to eight 1-year scholarships of \$1000.00 each (seven public school and one home schooled Non-traditional students may apply independently.). Each will be payable to the student's school at the beginning of the instructional period.

The recipients will be current graduating High School seniors and a student who meets state graduating criteria and as a home schooled in the Green Valley area. A recipient may also be an adult who previously graduated from a high school and wishes to enroll (or is now enrolled) in a post-secondary school.

The selections will be made by a committee composed of not less than three members of the Green Valley Rotary Club Foundation. They shall be the Vice President of the Foundation, who will chair the selection committee, the Treasurer of the Green Valley Rotary Club Foundation or their appointee, and the chairperson of the Vocational Service Committee. Substitutes for any of the above positions may be made by the Foundation President.

The evaluation process will be as follows:

1. Applications will be made available for students no later than January of the year of the award.
2. Applications must be on the official Rotary Club form and be received by the Foundation Vice-President or appointee by date determined each year
3. The following criteria shall be used in the evaluation process:
 - a. High school achievement record
 - b. Extracurricular clubs and activities
 - c. Essay
 - d. Personal interviews are permitted and are scheduled by the chair, if necessary, to complete the selection process
 - e. Financial Need
4. Students will be notified of an award by the Foundation Vice-President. This shall include both winners and those not selected. All scholarship correspondence between the Foundation and the students will use the official Rotary Club mailing post office box address.
5. The Foundation Treasurer shall send the scholarship funds directly to the educational institution.

Finalists may be invited to an interview with the Selection Committee.

This application must be received at the address above by **Friday, April 7, 2017**. Late applications will not be considered.

All applications will be evaluated on the following criteria:

1. Graduating Senior residing in the Green Valley/Sahuarita area
2. Academic achievement
3. Extra-curricular and Community Service activities
4. Essay
5. Personal interview
6. Financial need

This is a \$1000.00 scholarship for one academic year. You must maintain a GPA of at least 2.5 with a minimum of 12 semester hours each session. An unofficial transcript must be submitted to the Green Valley Rotary Foundation Chairperson at the end of fall semester.
